Marcia Road is tucked away off the Old Kent Road, in close proximity to the proposed Bakerloo Line extension, Burgess Park and numerous local amenities. Bermondsey and Elephant & Castle are both nearby.

The sitting room is set to front of the property with a lovely bay window. To the rear is a generous kitchen, with integrated appliances and space for a large dining table, as well as a downstairs WC. Leading out from the kitchen-diner is a private walled garden.

The three larger bedrooms are all generous double rooms, with ample space for storage. There is an additional fifth bedroom/study room on the first floor, plus two family bathrooms.

Spread over almost 1,300 sq ft, this is a substantial, three storey, family home, yet retaining significant extension potential both into the loft and to the rear of the property. There is existing precedent along the road, in both respects.
