A remarkable former Gothic church residence dating from the 1860s, rich in original period character and architectural charm. Distinctive ecclesiastical features, including striking silhouettes and leaded stained glass details, make this an exceptionally unique home.

The property offers an equally charming layout with four bedrooms alongside generous open-plan living accommodation, a fitted kitchen with breakfast bar and two bathrooms. The house is entered through an ornate original brick porch which opens into an impressive open-plan reception space with fireplace, there is an integrated kitchen with a secret staircase down to the guest room.

To the back of the property is a huge dining/living space with doors leading out onto a private garden. In addition there is a well appointed family bathroom. The property also benefits from a charming private rear garden offering a peaceful outdoor retreat.

Westfield Road is one of Surbiton's premier river roads with everything you need less than half a mile away, including the River Thames, desirable Maple Road, as well as Surbiton Station, which operates a fast train to Waterloo in 16 minutes.
