Behind the classic brick facade lies a bright and inviting interior finished to an exceptional standard. The ground floor opens with a welcoming entranceway, leading to a spacious open-plan living and dining area, which opens out onto a large south-facing garden.


At the heart of the home sits a striking Harvey Jones kitchen, fitted with premium appliances and a central island, topped with concrete and quartz work surfaces - both heat and stain resistant. Expansive floor-to-ceiling glass doors frame the view of the private garden and flood the space with natural light. Clever under-stair storage maximises practicality.

Upstairs, three comfortable double bedrooms and a stylish bathroom are arranged around a central landing. The bathroom features a skylight, bath, and separate shower, creating a serene space, bathed in natural light.
