This third floor one bedroom flat has a bright reception room, a kitchenette, shower room, hallway with two cupboards and a good sized bedroom with a large fitted wardrobe. Situated in London's legal quarter close to Holborn Circus, Fleet Street and the Law Courts. A blue plaque outside commemorates Virginia and Leonard Woolf, former residents of the block. A good selection of restaurants are close by on Cheapside, Paternoster Square and One New Change shopping centre.



Nestled next to the Grade II listed Maughan library, formerly the headquarters of the Public Record Office, known as the "strong-box of the Empire" and was acquired by Kings College in 1998. Inside the library is a dodecagonal reading room, inspired by that of the British Museum, and a former medieval chapel, now an exhibition space showcasing the special collections of the library. A blue plaque on the building commemorates past residents Virginia and Leonard Woolff.


